THOM MAYNE was a founder of the Southern California Institute of Architecture and has held teaching positions at Columbia University, Harvard University, Yale University, the Berlage Institute in the Netherlands and the Bartlett School of Architecture in London. He holds a tenured faculty position at the UCLA School of the Arts and Architecture.

His honors include Pritzker Prize Laureate, 2005; Rome Prize Fellowship from the American Academy of Design in Rome, 1987; Alumni of the Year Award from USC, 1992; Member Elect from the American Academy of Arts and Letters, 1992; and the 2000 American Institute of Architects/Los Angeles Gold Medal in Architecture.

Under Thom Mayne's direction, his firm MORPHOSIS has received numerous awards and has been the subject of extensive publications and exhibitions.
